

The Indigenous People of the Lower River Murray Lakes and Coorong, known as the Ngarrindjeri, first flew and adopted this flag on the 21st of November 1999, on Kumarangk - Ngarrindjeri Ruwe.



Story of the Ngarrindjeri Flag

- The 18 dots represent the 18 Laklanyeri (tribes) that make up the Ngarrindjeri nation
- The spears represent the traditional fishing spears of the Ngarrindjeri
- The Boomerang is the Sacred Boomerang that when thrown, circles the Laklanyeri informing their clan leaders to attend a National Meeting called Tendi (Tendi makes and interprets Ngarrindjeri Law)
- The Blue represents the waters which surround Ngarrindjeri country
- The Sun is the giver of life
- The Ochre colour of the Boomerang represents our Mother – Mother Earth
